Dear Ms. Gibson,

The Alaska Gasline Development Corporation (AGDC) has asked BP Exploration (Alaska), Inc. (BPXA) as the Prudhoe Bay Unit (PBU) and West Dock Operator to acknowledge in writing that we have met with AGDC regarding the proposed project and activities at West Dock as described in their Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement (SEIS) review with the U.S. Corps of Engineers. BPXA is aware of multiple parties progressing plans for a major gas project on the North Slope and that West Dock will be an integral asset to any such plans.

AGDC has discussed the Alaska Stand Alone Pipeline (ASAP) project and expected West Dock modifications with BPXA on multiple occasions. While no specific agreements have been reached at this time BPXA will continue to engage with all parties progressing gas projects on the North Slope. The specific plans AGDC has provided in support of their SEIS application do not conflict with BPXA's current understanding of potential future West Dock expansion for a major gas project. Agreements will need to be developed in the future regarding construction and operations of any West Dock expansion but at this time BPXA does not anticipate being unable to successfully agree to commercial terms to support a major gas project.

BPXA also understands that the ASAP project will work with BP, the State of Alaska and USACE regarding future authorizations for a tide land lease and dredge/fill permits. BPXA will continue to support the development of a major gas project on the North Slope and will work with the USACE and other agencies on a coordinated permitting plan to ensure the success of a major gas project and continued PBU Operations.
