The purpose of this Addendum #3 is to:

a. *Provide further clarification regarding the intent of Section 7 as follows:*

The scope of work/scope of services described at Section 7 of the RFP describes elements of focus in order to help proposers understand the experience and skill sets required to allow AGDC to select the most qualified Offeror capable of producing the economic feasibility study described in the RFP.

Once a contractor has been selected and engaged, AGDC and the contractor will review all elements listed in Section 7 of the RFP and will modify the scope of work/scope of services as may be necessary.

b. *Better define the term "Cook Inlet"*

Throughout the RFP, wherever the geographic area referenced as "Cook Inlet" is found, it shall be interpreted to mean existing tidewater ports located in Anchorage, Kenai, and Nikiski as well as other potential tidewater port sites within the Cook Inlet geographic area.

c. *Amend Section 7 as follows:*

Section 7.1 STUDY ASSUMPTIONS

This first portion of this section is amended to read: *"For the purposes of this study the GTL facility is assumed to be: 1) located at tidewater in Cook Inlet near the Alaska railroad and highway infrastructure and in Fairbanks, Alaska 2) ..."*

d. *Add a new deliverable to Section 7:*

Section 7.2 STUDY DELIVERABLES

The new section will read: *"Section 7.2.8 As a supplemental task, the Successful Offeror will be required to evaluate the capital and operating cost variances associated with siting the GTL plant in Fairbanks rather than Cook Inlet, and with determining the incremental transportation cost variances to deliver the GTL products to market, including rail, trucking, and pipeline tariffs."*

e. Extend the deadline for submitting proposals as follows:

See Section 3.4 DEADLINE FOR SUBMITTING A PROPOSAL.

This section is amended to read: *“The Offeror’s proposal and all supporting documentation must be delivered to the Contracting Officer no later than 4:00 pm local Anchorage time) on August 23, 2010.”*

All other provisions of the RFP remain the same.

A Reminder: Offerors will be required to acknowledge receipt of any/all addenda to the RFP when submitting their respective proposals by including a statement in their respective submittal (i.e. “Offeror has received and reviewed Addendum #1, Addendum #2, Addendum #3, etc.).
